SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTION

The Andrew L. Hicks, Jr., Foundation has established a \$10,000 scholarship in the memory of Andrew L. Hicks, Jr., Henderson High School Class of 2011. The purpose of the scholarship is to financially reward and assist a deserving Henderson High School student in achieving their goal of completing an undergraduate education at a four-year college or university. The annual scholarship will be used to promote youth volunteerism and community service to the students at Henderson High School.

Purpose: The Andrew L. Hicks, Jr. Foundation will be awarding one \$10,000 scholarship (\$2,500/year for up to four years) in the memory of Andrew L. Hicks, Jr., HHS Class of 2011, to financially assist a deserving Henderson High School student in achieving his or her goal of completing an undergraduate education at a four-year college or university. The annual scholarship will be used to promote youth volunteerism and community service to the students at Henderson High School.

Eligibility: Eligible applications must meet the following criteria to be considered for the Andrew L. Hicks, Jr. Memorial Scholarship:

- 1. Be a member in good standing of the 2020 graduating class of Henderson High School.
- 2. Either:
 - a. Participated in the Henderson High School Boys Soccer or Ice Hockey program for at least one full season during his high school career **and** also volunteered with the Andrew L. Hicks, Jr. Foundation at a minimum of one event; **OR**
 - b. Volunteered for a minimum of 40 hours with the Andrew L. Hicks, Jr. Foundation during his or her high school career (no HHS athletic participation required).
- 3. Attained a minimum 3.0 cumulative grade point average.
- 4. Be scheduled to graduate from Henderson High School in June 2020.
- 5. Have been accepted to, and is planning to attend a four-year college or university.

Deadline: Applications must be submitted to the Andrew L. Hicks, Jr. Foundation no later than **Friday, March 27, 2020**. Applications postmarked after this date will not be considered.

Application Process: Applicant must complete the scholarship application package, which includes an application form and a personal essay. The applicant's completed package should be submitted no later than the deadline either in person, by email, or by regular mail to:

Award: The Andrew L. Hicks, Jr. Memorial Scholarship is a four-year award totaling \$10,000. The recipient of the scholarship will be selected by the Foundation Board based on their ability to meet the scholarship criteria as well as demonstrate a desire to selflessly help others. The scholarship winner will receive the first year award of \$2,500 in August of 2020, prior to his or her first semester of college. The scholarship money may be applied to tuition costs only. The scholarship is renewable for up to three additional years. The recipient will remain eligible during the following three years by maintaining a 3.0 grade point average while in college **and** either volunteering at least 15 hours each year with the Andrew L. Hicks, Jr. Foundation, or participating in at least two Andrew L. Hicks, Jr. Foundation events involving the children of Chester prior to the beginning of the next year of college.

Distribution of Monies: Scholarship funds of \$2,500 per year, up to a total of \$10,000 over 4 years, will be paid to the recipient's school (on their behalf) prior to the start of each fall semester, as long as the recipient remains scholarship eligible, and submits a tuition bill to the Foundation.
